Woodside - Living Room TV Guide

There are two options for watching TV; 1) FreeSat, or 2) SMART TV.

Option 1 – FreeSat

- Alongside the TV is a Manhattan FreeSat box. This should be used to watch all standard FreeSat channels (FreeSat is basically the same as Freeview, but with more channel choices).
- Turn on the Manhattan with it's remote control; the light in the Manhattan box will glow blue.
- On the TV, use the <u>input selection button</u> to select HDMI 1.
- You are now connected to the FreeSat box.
- Use the Manhattan remote control for everything except volume control.
- Use the Samsung remote for volume control.

Option 2 – SMART TV

- The TV is connected to the internet. By pressing the <u>SMART button</u> on the TV remote you can select from a range of online services including BBC iPlayer, ITV Player, 4OnDemand and most other standard online TV services.
- One you have selected the SMART button, use the <u>arrow buttons</u> to navigate around the options and the <u>select button</u> to select an option.
